The United Nations in the Kyrgyz Republic was opened in 1993; soon after the country gained its independence. The aim of the United Nations in the Kyrgyz Republic is to assist the country in achieving progress in the directions stated at The United Nations Development Assistance Framework and provide support in implementing the Sustainable Develop ment Goals.

At present, 27 UN Agencies, Funds and Programmes operate in the Kyrgyz Republic; 12 of them are nonresident agencies. The United Nations Resident Coordinator (UN RC) is the highest-ranking representative of the United Nations development system (UNDS) at the country level.







Since opening its Office in Kyrgyzstan in 1993, the WHO focuses on improving the population's health and addressing health inequalities, health sector reforms and enhancement of access of the population to quality health care services and medicines.

WHO cooperates with Kyrgyzstan with the aim of achieving Universal health coverage (UHC) and strengthening the health system, improving public health service capacity, addressing health security including selected communicable diseases and immunization and strengthening the control of non-communicable diseases.
